What are the responsibilities of the Base Student Services team?

Facilitating the CFB Halifax Student Program by finding students to employ through the Federal Student Work Experience
Program and through local university/college co-operative education programs. The team interviews students, handles security
clearances, manages paperwork, collaborates with Base managers, and assists human resources with problems that arise.

Who can use Base Student Services?

All managers on Base who would like to mentor and have meaningful work for students.

Where is the Base Student Services team located?

Base headquarters (S90) third floor room 334.

How many people work in the Base Student Services team?

Currently one full-time team member and two part-time team members who assist during the summer hiring season.

How does the Base Student Services team support Canadian Armed Forces activities/operations?

The team facilitates the hiring of students to foster growth within the public service, to provide new ideas and perspectives, to assist with the cultivation of talent, to uphold operational continuity, and to empower future leaders.

Are there any interesting facts to share about the Base Student Services team?

They have hired over 500 students and bridged over 50 students on Base within the last eight years.
