What are the responsibilities of the Dangerous Goods (DG) team?

Store, maintain, and dispose of DG material for the Canadian Armed Forces (CAF).

Who can use the DG team services?

CAF organizations in Nova Scotia.

Where is the DG Warehouse located?

Building D-207, His Majesty's Canadian Dockyard.

How many people work in the DG team?

10 Base Logistics members and 2 Fleet Maintenance Facility Cape Scott members.

How does the DG team support CAF members and/or operations?

Packs, stores, and disposes of DG material that is used in day-to-day operations, special projects, deployments, and training.

Are there any interesting facts to share about the DG team?

The team disposes of tens of millions of liters of DG waste (oil; fuel; glycol; toxic, corrosive, black & grey water), and at least 500,000 kgs of solid DG waste (batteries; corrosives; contaminated clothing; rags and filters; jetty waste; light bulbs; ink cartridges; asbestos; grease; paint; and toxic solids) per year.
