


BASE COMMANDER'S MESSAGE

On July 24, we welcomed Captain(N) M.S.A. (Annick) Fortin to our community as she assumed command of Canadian Forces Base (CFB) Halifax. With this appointment, Capt(N) Fortin becomes the 47th Base Commander of CFB Halifax. In this key leadership role, she will lead a skilled team of approximately 1,400 military and civilian Defence Team members who provide administrative, logistics, information technology and executive services support as well as port operations and emergency services to Maritime Forces Atlantic and local lodger units while maintaining our strong connection with the local community.



Originally from Trois-Rivières, Québec, Capt(N) Fortin joined the Canadian Armed Forces in 1991. Following initial training as a bridge watchkeeper, she joined the fleet as a member of HMCS *Huron* in 1998. She went on to specialize in Above Water Warfare and was subsequently posted to HMCS *Vancouver*. Throughout her career, Capt(N) Fortin has deployed to the Persian Gulf for Operation APOLLO and in support of Operation ALTAIR; to the Mediterranean Sea as part of Canada's ongoing contribution to NATO missions in central and Eastern Europe under Operation REASSURANCE and Operation SEA GUARDIAN; and to the Indo-Pacific for Operation PROJECTION. Capt(N) Fortin was appointed Executive Officer of HMCS *Ville De Québec* in 2017; served as Naval Fleet School Pacific Commandant from 2019 to 2021; and assumed Command of HMCS Regina in June 2021 followed by Command of HMCS *Winnipeg* in March 2022. She is a graduate of the Royal Military College of Canada in Kingston (1997), holds a Master of Defence Studies (2016) from the Canadian Forces College in Toronto and recently completed the National Security Programme at the Canadian Forces College in Toronto (2024).

Here is the new Base Commander's first official message: "It is a great honour to assume command of Canadian Forces Base Halifax, and to keep watch over Canada's East Coast naval base. I look forward to learning from and working with an exceptional team of civilian and military personnel as we continue to strengthen community ties, support our members and operations from ashore, and persevere through challenges together. I thank my predecessor, Captain(N) MacKenzie, for leaving a solid foundation for us to build upon; I am committed to ensuring that we remain united in our duty to serve."

In July 2024, the Canadian Armed Forces released <u>Fighting Spirit</u>. <u>The Profession of Arms in Canada</u>, the second publication in a series of doctrine that first started with <u>The Canadian Armed</u> <u>Forces Ethos: Trusted to Serve</u> (2022), both of which now replace <u>Duty with Honour. The Profession of Arms in Canada</u> (2009). "Fighting Spirit is a doctrinal guide that articulates the CAF's renewed commitment to professionalism by describing what it means to be a military professional and how to apply these

HMC Dockyard

- Dockyard Security Office: The actioning of Visitor Access Lists and car pass requests may take longer than usual. Please build in sufficient time when visiting this office.

Willow Park

Some of the IT services offered via assystNet include:

- <u>DWAN Account Guidance</u> Information and directions for dealing with network accounts when transferring in or out of a unit as well as support for deployments.
- <u>Defence Office365 Support</u> Provides information on how to get up and running with D365 as well as links to National sites for support.
- <u>Common offerings</u> such as resetting your network account and office telephone passwords, modifying file/folder permissions, requesting, or updating a PKI card or requesting new computer applications/software.
